A podcast on producing good digital content for teaching and learning which has been leaded by PLUS completes the OER section of the website.


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## LAST MULTIPLIER EVENTS

Finally, people which contributed to the project implementation met face-to-face for the first time in a sunny and windy Lisbon to take stock of activities and discuss the sustainability of project results.

Last 14 and 15 February representatives from all partner universities were hosted by Nova University for the Final Transnational Project Meeting, the first one in-person ENLIVEN meeting.

Considering the Covid-19 pandemic and according to the project proposal, the kick-off meeting and two intermediate meetings have been held remotely. The responsibility for the transnational project meetings has been shared among the partners.

During the meeting the outcomes of the various project activities were examined one by one to better understand which, to what extent and by using what resources their sustainability could be ensured beyond the end of the project. A sustainability plan for ENLIVEN was drafted upstream of the meeting. The maintenance of the website for the next three years and the commitment of all partners to update when needed and to continue in disseminating the results toward their stakeholders and toward the respective European University Alliances will ensure that ENLIVEN legacy does not scatter.

The relevance of the project in the current context, where technology is increasingly enhancing learning, was reaffirmed, and future collaboration in projects and knowledge sharing was encouraged as well.



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Among the ENLIVEN open educational resources many are videos. The module "On the use of Digital Content Producers" (leaded by PLUS) deals with the working process and the aspects that influence the creation of a good podcast: from finding interesting topics, collecting material and ideas, to the evaluation of the result. Technical aspects are also covered: technical equipment, the use of Audacity for recording, the creation, editing, and mixing of sounds.

All the modules can be used in different learning and teaching environments: in the context of a self-learning process as well as integrated in courses and teaching units.

To get access to the modules you can either download the zip-file with all the files to your device and start with "start.pdf" or you click on "View", start with the first page, and navigate with the links in the files (use the backand forward-button in your browser). A 5 minute survey allows to give your feedback on the contents.

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Paris Lodron University of Salzburg hosted the Multiplier Event "How to Enlive Digital Education" on January 30. After the presentation of ENLIVEN results, the subsequent discussion focused on how they could be used in the long term in everyday learning and teaching.

NOVA University Lisbon hosted the Multiplier Event "Online Teaching and Learning – Digital World after COVID-19", within the ENLIVEN project. The event took place on January 31 and was attended by more than 80 national and international participants. After the opening session, there was a brief presentation on education in the post-pandemic context – soon followed by the results of the ENLIVEN project.

On February 7 in Universität Hamburg the multiplier event was totally remote and in German language to present the project results to an audience of local external stakeholders. The event was particularly interactive, and a concise and representative infographic was instantly created.
